

## **TERMS OF USE**

Welcome to the Navy Pier web site of The Metropolitan Pier and Exposition Authority (“the MPEA”). These Terms of Use provide general information about the MPEA and its products and services as they relate to [navypier.com](http://navypier.com). These Terms of Use apply only to the Navy Pier web site, located at [www.navypier.com](http://www.navypier.com) (the “Web Site”), and not to any other web sites owned or operated by the MPEA.

All users of the Web Site are subject to the following terms and conditions of use (these “Terms of Use”). Please read these Terms of Use carefully before accessing or using any part of the Web Site. **By accessing or using the Web Site, you agree that you have read, understand, and agree to be bound by these Terms of Use, as amended from time to time, as well as the Navy Pier [Privacy Policy](#), which is hereby incorporated into these Terms of Use.** If you do not wish to agree to these Terms of Use, do not access or use any part of the Web Site. The MPEA may revise and update these Terms of Use at any time without notice by posting the amended terms to the Web Site. Your continued use of the Web Site means that you accept and agree to the revised Terms of Use. If you disagree with the Terms of Use (as amended from time to time) or are dissatisfied with the Web Site, your sole and exclusive remedy is to discontinue using the Web Site.
