Seadog I and II are mono-hull boats 70 ft long and 18 ft wide, carrying 125 passengers. Seadog IV is a catamaran-hull 80 ft long and 24 ft wide, carrying 142 passengers. Each boat is equipped with two turbo-charged diesel engines, each of the two producing 700 – 1200 horsepower. Seadogs I, II and IV offer thrilling speedboat rides along Lake Michigan as well as architectural river cruises. The all new **Seadog Extreme** offers an even more intense and jet-propelled experience. Weather permitting, each speedboat will operate through October.
