- DESCRIPTION:** Harry Caray's Tavern, Navy Pier, opening March 1, 2010, is located near the main entrance to Navy Pier and offers a one-of-a-kind dining experience. The restaurant's waterfront location, family-friendly menu and museum quality collection of Chicago sports memorabilia will delight guests of all ages. The extensive menu includes flavorful sandwiches and wraps, pastas, fresh salads and homemade pizzas. Guests can also enjoy several favorites from the legendary Harry Caray's Italian Steakhouse, as well as Harry's signature Holy Cow!® Burger Bar. Harry's museum is located within the restaurant and features a rotating collection of museum-quality sports memorabilia celebrating Chicago sports legends, both past and present. The mahogany paneled walls, pressed tin ceiling and signature tiled floors create a truly warm Chicago atmosphere. In the warmer months, the expansive patio with an island bar provides a front row seat to enjoy the beauty of Lake Michigan, along with the sights and sounds of Navy Pier. With 30 flat screen TVs located throughout the bar, dining room and patio, Harry's is Navy Pier's best spot to watch sporting events of all kinds. Harry's can accommodate 300 guests inside and 215 on the patio.

MENU:

The family-friendly menu includes a wide selection of fresh salads, flavorful sandwiches, homemade pizzas, pastas and hearty entrées. Favorites from the legendary Harry Caray's Italian Steakhouse include Harry's award-winning Chicken Vesuvio, Calamari and Chili. Harry's signature Holy Cow!® Burger Bar. Burger options include the finest varieties of beef, including Japanese style Wagyu beef and Bill Kurtis' grass-fed Tallgrass Beef, along with turkey, vegetarian and salmon. Guests can select from a wide selection of preparations, toppings, and buns, allowing them to create their perfect burger. Entrée prices range from \$6.95 to \$15.95.

While many of the menu offerings are child-friendly, Harry's also offers a separate children's menu which includes activities to keep little hands busy. A scavenger hunt, complete with prizes, engages the older children in the family.

DÉCOR & MUSEUM: The décor reflects Harry Caray's signature style with mahogany paneled walls, pressed tin ceiling and mosaic tile floor. Located throughout the restaurant is an extensive collection of artifacts, celebrity photographs and vintage newspapers, which celebrate Chicago sports legends and events, past and present.

Harry's museum, located within the restaurant, features beautifully crafted display cabinets with a rotating collection of museum-quality sports memorabilia. One of the most unique items on display is the remains of the Infamous Cubs Foul Ball deflected by fans during the Cubs' 2003 playoff loss to the Florida Marlins. The ball was later destroyed by Harry Caray's with the help of Oscar winning Special Effects Director Michael Lantieri. Other notable items include Geovany Soto's full catcher's gear worn during his rookie year, the White Sox bat that hit the last out in the 2005 World Series game and Harry Caray's signature eyeglasses.

AUDIO VISUAL: 30 high-def flat screen televisions surround the indoor and outdoor bars, and are also strategically placed throughout the dining room, featuring sporting events of all kinds. A popular tradition at all Harry Caray's locations is the nightly "Sing Along with Harry." Harry's famous rendition of *Take Me Out to the Ballgame* is played every evening at 7:30pm and everyone in the bar is invited to join in.

OUTDOORDINING: Guests entering Navy Pier's Dock Street are welcomed by Harry Caray's expansive patio, which accommodates 215 guests, and offers the perfect place to enjoy the beauty of Lake Michigan and the excitement of Navy Pier. HDTVs mounted around the bar provide great outdoor viewing of all major sporting events. Additionally, passersby can walk up to the outdoor island bar, order a drink, and take it with them as they continue their stroll down the Pier.

PRIVATE PARTIES: Harry Caray's Tavern is ideal for private parties of any size. With accommodations for groups ranging from 20-500 guests, Harry's is the perfect venue for tour groups, corporate events and social celebrations for both children and adults.
